### What is BikeX.org?

- We take in bike donations from families like yours, refurbish them, and donate them to those in need both to students and adults.
- Bikes provide essential transportation to work, education and health care, along with exercise.
- We train volunteers in the art of bicycle repair while refurbishing our bikes
- We sell high-end used bikes and new parts and accessories to cover operating costs.
- We're in Palo Alto down by the Bay. We've been donating bikes since 1993.



#### BikeX & Cupertino Schools - Bikes for Students

- We can provide bikes to students who can't afford them, as well as lights, locks and helmets.
- We're hoping to formalize relationships with schools, districts, cities and counties to identify these students, queue up right-sized bikes, and make these donations sustainable through funding.



## BikeX & Cupertino Schools - Bikes for Students

- Bike Drives: Schools can co-host bike drives to help supply bikes we'll donate back to the school.
- Bike Repair: We can provide repair services to keep student bikes in good working order. A typical event costs \$1500.
- Used Bikes for Sale: For those who can afford a used bike, we sell refurbished used bikes with a warranty. shop.bikex.org
