



## Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration

**Project Title:** I-280 Trail (formerly known as Junipero Serra Trail)

**City/County:** City of Cupertino, Santa Clara County, California

**Public Review Period:** June 30, 2022 to August 1, 2022

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Cupertino (City) has prepared a Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the **I-280 Trail Project (formerly known as Junipero Serra Trail)**, which is available beginning on June 30, 2022 for review and comment by the public and all interested persons, agencies, and organizations for a period of 30 days, ending on August 1, 2022. All comments on the Draft MND must be received by that date.

**Project Location:** The project sites are located in the City of Cupertino, primarily within Valley Water right-of-way for Junipero Serra Channel and Calabazas Creek, between North De Anza Boulevard and Vallco Parkway.

**Project Description:** The City is implementing a project to construct an approximately 1.68-mile shared use trail along the Junipero Serra Channel and Calabazas Creek between North De Anza Boulevard and Vallco Parkway in the City of Cupertino. The purpose of the project is to construct the central and eastern portions of I-280 Trail formerly known as the Junipero Serra Trail, which will ultimately become part of "The Loop" trail around Cupertino as envisioned in the 2016 Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan.

**Potentially Significant Environmental Effects:** Potentially significant impacts in the following areas are discussed in the Mitigated Negative Declaration: Biological Resources, Cultural and Tribal Cultural Resources, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, and Noise. Each potentially significant effect is reduced to a less-than-significant level through mitigation.

**Public Review and Comment:** Comments on the Draft MND must be received by August 1, 2022.
