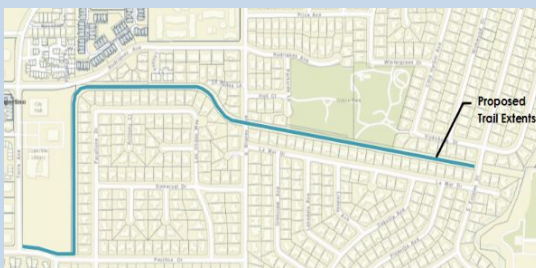


# Cupertino Safe Routes to School



## Regnart Creek is Going to Council

Regnart Creek is in the design phase! This means engineers are working to finalize the details of the trail's design, such as how wide the trail will be, where fences could be installed, how intersection crossings could be handled, and other details. On Tuesday, May 21, Cupertino City Council will be presented with the 65% design. This design is complete enough to illustrate what to expect from the final design, while still allowing room for input before the design is finalized.
