

#### **Hours of Operation:**

7:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. & 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m

**PEDESTRIANS**: only cross the street when the WALK sign is illuminated. Stay on the sidewalk at all other times.

#### **CYCLISTS**: You have a choice:

- Ride across during the green light for vehicles
- Dismount and walk in the crosswalk with the pedestrians during the WALK phase


**DRIVERS**: only turn right when you have a green light. Right turns during a red light will no longer be allowed.


