

'FAQ' from the Frontlines

Pedestrian Scramble

Hours of Operation:

7:45 a.m. to 8:35 a.m. & 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m

PEDESTRIANS: only cross the street when the WALK sign is illuminated. Stay on the sidewalk at all other times.

CYCLISTS: You have a choice:

- Ride across during the green light for vehicles
- Dismount and walk in the crosswalk with the pedestrians during the WALK phase
- Ride next to the crosswalk during the walk phase

DRIVERS: only turn right when you have a green light. Right turns during a red light will no longer be allowed.


