


GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT AUTHORIZATION TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2019

CUPERTINO

Proposals for development that include General Plan amendments are reviewed by the City Council twice a year. At that time, the Council decides whether or not the applicant may submit an application for a General Plan amendment. Authorization does not guarantee approval of the projects. Authorization directs staff to review the submitted application, including project, environmental review and public outreach.



2019 First Cycle Proposal:

On Tuesday, November 5, 2019, the City Council will consider:

Canyon View GPAAuth-2019-01 (APN#'s 356-27-026, 356-05-007, 356-05-008) adjacent to Linda Vista Park

The proposed project is to allow 29 units where four units are currently allowed on an 86-acre hillside property with an average slope of ~48% which would require General Plan Amendments to change the existing General Plan Land Use Designation. The City Council will review the 2019 First Cycle proposals and decide whether to authorize the proposal as a General Plan amendment application.
